

7 Great Interview Tips

1. DO YOUR RESEARCH

The more you know about and organization the better prepared you will be to answer specific questions.

2. LOOK YOUR BEST

First impressions are important, the way you dress says a lot about how serious you are about the interview

3. Portfolio & Resume

Your portfolio is an extension of your resume. It is a collection of official documents and a collection of sample work.

4. PRACTICE

Have a friend ask you questions or ask them in the mirror and practice your response.

5. CONFIDENCE

At the start of the interview, you may have the opportunity to give your 15-seconds of self-promotion.

6 BE READY FOR ANYTHING

Be ready to discuss your plans and goals. You may be asked detailed questions.

7. HAVE QUESTIONS

Typically, at the end of the interview the interviewer gives you a chance to ask questions.
